This 8-days tour takes you to the most important cities in Andalusia. This tour is a good choice to get to know all that Andalusia has to offer. The trip starts in Málaga, the birthplace of Pablo Picasso. The city will surprise you with its history, monuments, and modern lifestyle. The following morning, you'll drive to Ronda, a town in the mountains of Málaga. The poet Rainer Maria Rilke wrote delightedly: "Ronda is enthroned on a rocky plateau, offering a breathtaking landscape, on the edge of a deep ravine". Afterwards, continue towards Seville, the capital of Andalusia. The Guadalquivir, the leading role in historical events, flows through this city. The cathedral, the picturesque Jewish quarter with its narrow streets and the Maria Luisa Park are just some of the sights in this enchanting city. On our way through Magical Andalusia you will reach Córdoba, the highlight of which is the Mezquita Cathedral, inherited from the great Caliphs of al-Andalus. It preserves the most beautiful architectural jewels of Islam and Christianity in one and the same temple, a World Heritage Site! After Seville and Cordoba comes Granada! The beauty of this city is also difficult to put into words, it is so stunning. The legendary Nasrid palaces of the Alhambra, the Albaicín quarter with its narrow streets to the San Nicolás viewpoint, from where you can enjoy the most beautiful, impressive view of the Alhambra with the Sierra Nevada in the background. From Granada you drive back to Málaga, where you have the last day at disposal.

### ITINERARY:

**DAY 1:** Welcome to Andalusia! On arrival at the hotel on the Costa del Sol, you can spend the rest of the day relaxing and enjoying the hotel facilities or taking a walk along the beach. Dinner at the hotel on the Costa del Sol

**DAY 2:** After breakfast, the journey begins! You set off towards Ronda. Sightseeing with a local guide. You will take a pleasant walk and enjoy the magnificent views that this city offers. Afterwards you will have free time in Ronda before continuing to Seville. Dinner at the hotel in Seville.

**DAY 3:** You wake up in one of the most beautiful cities in Spain, Seville. With a local guide you will get to know the city, which can look back on more than three thousand years of history. You will walk through the narrow streets of the Santa Cruz district and visit the cathedral. The afternoon is free at leisure. Dinner at the hotel in Seville.

**DAY 4:** After breakfast, departure to Córdoba. The city most identified with the splendor of the Islamic period on the Peninsula. Accompanied by a local guide, you will discover the magic of the Jewish quarter and the imposing Mosque-Cathedral. You will then have some free time. Continue the journey to Granada. Dinner at the hotel in Granada

IMPORTANT INFORMATION: The visit of the Alhambra\* will be adapted to the specified access of the tickets.


The journey continues to Malaga. Dinner at the hotel at the Costa del Sol
